1 Getting Started

Create PDF Bookmarks for Subsections

Use the `automateframe` environment to automatically create subsections with pdf bookmarks.

```
\automateframe{"Subsection"}{  
  "Insert Text"  
}
```

The inputs are the subsection title and the main text. This macro also allows the continuation of information in the next slide by using `allowframebreaks`.

Subsections and Blocks

While using blocks, define your frame as shown below.

```
\begin{frame}[fragile,allowframebreaks]{Subsection Title}
\subsection{Subsection Title}
\begin{block}
  Text
\end{block}\end{frame}
```

I am unable to automate the subsection bookmarks for a fragile frame. I will update the template if I find a solution.

- To remove the Table of Contents before every section, comment the following code in `beamertheme_statale.sty`.

Table of Contents

```
\AtBeginSection[]{\begingroup\themecolor{main}\begin{frame}[allowframebreaks]{Table of Contents}\tableofcontents[currentsection]\end{frame}\endgroup}
```

- To hide subsections in Table of Contents,

Subsections

```
\setbeamertemplate{subsection in toc}{}
```

- To change the style, change

Style of Contents

```
\setbeamertemplate{section in toc}{\$\blacktriangleright$\inserttocsection}
```



Hyperlinks

1 Getting Started

- Beamer buttons are a unique way to represent clickable links. To create one,

```
\hyperref{"Link"}{\beamerbutton{"Insert Text"}} Test
```

- To create a link to a particular point in the presentation,

- Create a hypertarget

```
\hypertarget{target}{}
```

- To create a hyperlink, use the target

```
\hyperlink{target}{Text}
```



Title Page

1 Getting Started

- To add multiple authors,
 - Define the following for each author

```
\newcommand{\secondauthor}[2]{\defsecondauthor{#1}\defsecondauthorid{#2}}
```
 - Modify the title page style to include

```
\ifdefempty{secondauthor}{}{%  
\usebeamerfont{author}\usebeamercolor[fg]{author}  
\textbf{secondauthor} \ifdefempty{secondauthorid}{}{(secondauthorid)}}}
```
 - In `Main.tex`, include the details of the second author as

```
\secondauthor{"Name"}{"ID"}
```

Repeat the same for any additional authors.



Title Page

- To reposition the text, change the spacing in `beamertheme_statale.sty` at line 155.

```
\hspace{-12mm}
```

```
\vspace{20mm}
```

- To modify the picture style, modify the `sidepic` environment at line 254 in `beamertheme_statale.sty`.
- To replace the picture, replace the path in line 20 of `Main.tex`.






 frmtxt	Frame Environment Color
